I am an installation artist, painter, and sculptor. Often austere and contemplative, mixed media works are made from found objects, antique woods and organic materials such as grasses, bamboo, rock, red-twig willow. By juxtaposing found objects and raw materials, often with hand-executed images, installations expose feelings of isolation, and solitude. Contextually, my work exposes women's and environmental concerns.
